President's Report	The COC board has filled 2 vacancies including Dawn Revyn from Volunteers of America and Marie Kaczynski.	
	 The 2018 NOFA was released on June 20th with the guidelines being coming out on June 28th. We had completed the Grant Inventory Worksheet earlier in the year which will be beneficial to us. 	
	 Jackie Merchant would have the Annual Renewal Demand Amount, but, unfortunately, she was not able to attend the committee meeting today. 	
	 Dawn discussed the ranking process and stated there has been some concern in the membership that our priorities need to shift. We need to hold a meeting to discuss the current needs of our community. We will be holding a meeting to see if our needs still match up. Dawn let everyone know that Jackie Merchant informed her that those submitting applications should not be attending the meeting. A discussion ensued regarding if the date and time of the meeting and if the meeting would be open to all community members and applicants. Dawn stated the goal is to be as transparent as possible. The meeting 	

	should consider available data and analysis of that data. Members suggested that providers understand the needs of the community. In the past transitional housing was eliminated due to not being involved, a member when on to suggest that HUD does not regulate this, we need to give them the information. Per HUD- We are trusting the COC tells us what your community needs. It was discussed that Mitch Alexander should facilitate the meeting as a Consultant. He has a lot of experience with the NOFA process. Following membership discussion, Richard Cannon motioned that the meeting be open to all members and early next week allowing members to plan on attending, if choosing to do so. The call in line will be set up for those not able to attend in person. A meeting notice will go out to membership. Meeting was scheduled Tuesday July 17 th 10:00 AM- 12:00PM at the MFRC. Last year all Tier 1 and Tier 2 were funded, but we did not receive the nonuse. Tier 1 always gets funded and if outcomes are good, then Tier 2 gets funded. Dawn read HUD priorities for 2018.

Grant Ranking- Heather explained the ranking committee is currently looking to rank this year's applicants. She and Sama Harp co-chair the 	

Compliance- A couple of reviews have occurred with scheduling of 2 additional reviews soon. The plan is to review all HUD funded agencies prior to the ranking committee's work. Community engagement Outreach- The committee has met 3 times and has 3 upcoming gatherings. Community Housing Prioritization- Tabled HMIS Data Quality- Service Point will be down for 3 hours sometime in the next few weeks. The system will be down from approximately 11 AM- 2 PM, but the date is not yet known. CAPER Reports are looking good. The Data Quality Sign off sheet has worked well with submission on the 5 th and all corrections completed by the 19 th . Fric Burton, CHN - Gave update on projects and reported that CHN plans to submit the Erin Park development application again for the October LIHTC funding. Macomb Health Department- Reported Hep A is now at an epidemic status throughout the entire State of Michigan and not just Macomb. There has not been any reported Hep A in Macomb County for the last 65-70 days. Community Announcements Community Connection Day- August 15 th 9AM- 3PM. Vaccines will be available for Hep A.
